

## SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS FOR HIRING VISITING PROFESSORS PPGF/UFBA - 2025

The Graduate Program in Philosophy (PPGF) of the Federal University of Bahia (UFBA) informs that applications are now open for Visiting Professor positions, according to Public Notice PV 022/2025 - PRPPG/UFBA - Simplified Selection Process for Hiring Visiting Professors (<a href="https://prppg.ufba.br/filebrowser/download/3775598">https://prppg.ufba.br/filebrowser/download/3775598</a>).

Applications must be submitted by sending the specified documentation exclusively through the form available at the link <a href="https://forms.gle/UxQq8ydVHLTaegpj9">https://forms.gle/UxQq8ydVHLTaegpj9</a> until **February 1st, 2026**, following the established schedule and with the following documents attached:

- 1) Filled Registration Form, available at the link https://prppg.ufba.br/filebrowser/download/3775596
- Work plan of up to 10 pages, detailing the academic and scientific activities to be conducted within the Graduate Program in Philosophy during the period of employment. This includes teaching, advising, research, technical and bibliographic production, with an explicit schedule and anticipated outcomes/results resulting from the actions of the selected professor within the scope of the PPG, their concentration area(s), and research line(s). The work plan should not be solely a research project, as investigative activities are among the duties to be fulfilled during the contract. The work plan must be signed and initialed by the candidate, in PDF format;
- 3) Curriculum Vitae (CV) of the candidate, in PDF format;

- 4) PhD diploma, in PDF format;
- **5)** Affirmative Action Applicants: Candidates who choose to apply for positions reserved for Black (preto/pardo), Indigenous, Quilombola, or persons with disabilities must indicate this option in the PRPPG/UFBA Application Form, which will serve as their initial self-declaration.

For this internal stage, the following documents must be attached, when applicable: Indigenous candidates: documents required under item 5.11 of Public Notice PV 022/2025; Quilombola candidates: documents required under item 5.12; Persons with disabilities: medical report and documentation required under item 6.6.1. Black candidates (pretos/pardos) do not need to upload any documentation at this stage, as the self-declaration is recorded solely in the PRPPG Application Form. After the internal stage, all affirmative-action applications will undergo complementary verification procedures (heteroidentification or document review) conducted directly by PRPPG/UFBA, in accordance with Public Notice PV 022/2025.

The PPGF/UFBA Board will establish a ranking order and submit it for selection at the University. The final decision rests with UFBA, which has a limited number of vacancies available for selection among all programs at the university.
